

Topic: UP Express September 2019 Service Changes

Date Update: September 3, 2019

There will be two temporary service changes on the UP Express in September 2019.

1. On Sunday, September 15, UP Express service will not be running until 8:30 a.m. so that the City of Toronto can work on the future pedestrian bridge connecting King Street West with Liberty Village. More information is available [here](#).

- Metrolinx will replace train service with shuttle buses that run every 20 minutes between Union and Pearson. The buses won't stop at Bloor or Weston.
- Replacement buses at Union Station will be parked at York Street/Station Street by the GoodLife Fitness Gym while those at Pearson will be at Terminal 1.
- Passengers won't be able to tap their Presto cards on the buses. They will have to tap their cards at either the Union or Pearson UP Express terminal.
- Guest Service Representatives will help with wayfinding and help guide passengers to the buses from the terminals. There will also be guest service representatives with wireless printers by the buses for passengers who want to buy a one-way ticket with a credit card.

2. On Saturday, Sept. 21 and Sunday, Sept. 22, UP Express service will be reduced to every 30 minutes and the duration of train trips will increase to 40 minutes from 25 minutes so that Metrolinx can replace the switch panel and upgrade signals in the Union Station Rail Corridor. Trains will continue to stop at Weston and Bloor Stations during this service adjustment.
